Double triples success for England in Commonwealth Games warm-up

England won two gold medals at the Delhi Test Tournament held as a warm-up ahead of the Commonwealth Games in October.

Mark Bantock, Graham Shadwell and Robert Newman beat New Zealand 7-5, 9-2 to win the men's triples.

Jamie-Lea Winch, Sandy Hazell and Sian Gordon won the women's triples thanks to a 4-3 win in the tie-break against Australia.

There was further success when Mervyn King and Sam Tolchard, replacing Stuart Airey who was unwell, teamed up to win a bronze medal in the men's pairs having beaten South Africa.

The women's pair of Natalie Melmore and Ellen Falkner narrowly missed out on a semi-final berth when they lost in a tie-break against Australia. England's singles representatives – Tolchard and Amy Monkhouse – were unable to make the final stages in their events despite several close games.
