### MEN

Singles: Sam Tolchard (Devon)

Pairs: Lead - Mervyn King (Norfolk); Skip - Stuart Airey (Cumbria)

Triples: Lead - Mark Bantock (Berkshire), Two - Graham Shadwell (Wiltshire); Skip - Robert Newman (Berkshire)

John Bell said: "The final selection of positions and combinations has followed a rigorous, and very successful, programme of games against strong opposition both domestically and overseas.
