Dorset duo to represent England in 2010 Michael Ashton-Phillips International Bowls Challenge

Dorset's Jamie Lockwood and Martin Pavey will represent England in the prestigious Michael Ashton-Phillips International Bowls Challenge.

Following an invitation extended to all junior and senior international triallists that drew a large response, the reigning Men's National Pairs Champions have been selected as the two players to be endorsed by Bowls England for the event that will be held in Southern California from Sunday 3rd to Saturday 9th October.

The competition is split into two – with a singles competition on the first three days and then a pairs competition in the second half of the week.

Tony Allcock MBE, Bowls England Chief Executive, said: "England has participated in this event for several years, and the feedback we receive from those who participate is very positive. I am sure that Jamie and Martin will prove to be excellent ambassadors for us this year and we are delighted to endorse their participation."
